Checklist

- Separate out multiples of a product, bulky excess products and first aid kits to locate elsewhere.
- Create personal caddies for each family member and organize products in them. Locate these caddies in their bedroom.
- Create storage where appropriate; verticle, wall space, etc., to store high use and common use items. Create store for small like items (plastic lidded bins, baskets, etc.)
- Clean and sanitize all fixtures, drawers, and cabinets.
- Restock the newly cleaned and organized bathroom.
