

# Day 3: Front Entry Foyer

## Checklist:

- Assess what needs to be kept near the front door, and what doesn't. Remove everything that isn't absolutely necessary, especially if it invites clutter.
- Organize items that will stay in the entry and contain them in attractive containers that fit with the décor of your home.
- Vacuum every corner, including area rugs, and dust the floorboards. You'll be so happy you did! And while you're dusting - dust any pieces of furniture as well.
- Using an extended duster, run it up the corners of the room.
- If you have any windows, use a bit of glass cleaner.
- Finally, don't neglect the front door. Thoroughly dust and/or wash it.
- Relocate items you're moving away from the entry and find their new home!
